## Feeding the Hungry

What do you think of when you hear the phrase, "Feeding the Hungry"? Do you visualize lines of people waiting for the soup kitchen to open? Do you see children holding empty bowls up for someone to fill?

These are all times that the phrase "Feeding the Hungry" applies, however there are types of "food" that are not for physical relief. Sometimes, Feeding the Hungry can mean simply sitting down on the sidewalk and listening to someone's problem. Hearing their problems and just loving them through the hurt.

We are privileged to be invited into the lives of some of the most unlovable people on the face of the earth. They are the "forgotten ones", living on the streets, making much out of very little. These people live day to day with hunger and dealing with the elements. They call themselves invisible.

Several times a week at least four of us go into Atlanta. Our destination is Little Five Points, Finley Park. We are anticipated greatly we have found. Sometimes we are able to provide some food. **Taco Bell in Union City often adds Tacos to our order, bought with money donated by generous people. Burger King in Morrow, has donated burgers and fries.**

On some days we find new arrivals, traveling through, stopping for a rest. We always greet them and are often treated to new stories of 'life on the road'. Their eyes are haunted, filled with hurt, hunger, hopelessness and sometimes anger. We tell them about the hope that is Jesus Christ, often it is accepted giving us cause for celebration. Other times it isn't, giving us cause for prayer.

We ask for your prayers. Please remember us and those that we minister to in your daily prayers. Pray that we will reach hearts that often are shut tight, that we will see that spark of understanding and acceptance of the precious gift of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Many Thanks and prayers of blessings have gone up for these and everyone that have been so generous to the homeless of Atlanta.

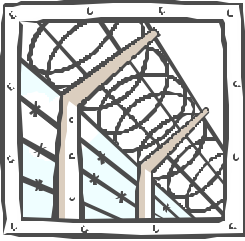
Needs are great all over the world, but none are greater than those in our own back yard.

At least you are certain of some things, your time in prison, release date and a meal three times a day. Your children are not.

One evening brings visitors from *Angel Tree Ministries*. They tell you how they can help you to provide gifts and contact your children this Christmas. So you sign up, check off the 2 items you'd like to see your children receive and turn in the application.

Then one day you get a letter from Angel Tree Ministries telling you that your children have been "adopted" by *Providence Baptist Church and His Perfect Will Ministries*. They will purchase a gift, wrap it, and put your special message to your child on the package. They will even transport the gifts to them!



The blessing here is ours as well as the families we contact. We have the opportunity to bring the message of Jesus Christ to these children and their custodial parent, as we also bring them messages from their parent that is away.

This outreach opportunity is a direct result of the works done by the Prison Ministry. There are prisoners everyday that come to know the saving grace of Jesus Christ through Angel Tree, Bill Glass Champions for Life, and many other prison ministry organizations.
